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B. SUMMARY REPORT - Q3(calendar-Q1 PY) meeting 2024

1. Summary analysis of the local labor market based on the industry representative needs and education offerings.

Case Manager Michelle Bailey of CareerSource Gulf Coast provided an overview of our training case management services as requested by members.

- Ms. Bailey is based at Haney and works closely with staff and students. Last year
 28 Haney students were funded through CareerSource.
- A Case Manager is also located at Tyndall Air Force Base, Gulf Coast State College, the Gulf Franklin Center in Gulf County, and part-time in Franklin County.
- CareerSource provides workforce training scholarships for eligible students. WIOA is a means tested eligibility with the exception of the Dislocated Worker Program where dislocation from a job is the primary factor for eligibility, even if household income exceeds 250% of poverty level. Recipients must be at a household income that is 250% of the poverty level or less.. For example, requirements include a one income household making \$38,000 or less or a dual-income household making \$63,000 or less. This scholarship is supplemental to financial aid or other scholarships. Recipients must be entering training in a high demand occupation on the Targeted Occupations List with training occurring at an Eligible Training Provider. They can fund tuition, books, supplies, mileage reimbursement over 25 miles one way daily, uniforms, test prep, and testing fees.
- Nine of the 19 recent nursing graduates at Haney were CareerSource sponsored students.
- There is a new plan to expand WIOA training scholarships to Aviation students.
- Donna Pilson asked to meet with Ms. Bailey to connect CareerSource with community organizations that could fund Haney programs that are not on the high demand occupations list and are ineligible for this scholarship.
- 2. Information on priority industry sectors and occupations for the local area.
 - Discussed the TOL and how it plays a role in WIOA funded training.
- 3. Information on the status of existing talent pipelines for in-demand occupations.
 - Discussed how training provides for those who are changing careers due to experience and advancing on a career ladder as well as workers who are dislocated due to business closings or mergers and acquisitions.
