The After School Assistance Program (ASAP) is a City of Panama City Community Development program and one of Florida's 21st Century Learning Centers that is designed to help children who live in low income housing and/or those who are "at-risk" and to provide them a safe environment to get assistance with their homework. Our program has two locations, one in St. Andrews in the Pana Villa Apartment Complex (23 students) and the other is on the east side of town, located in the Glenwood area (approximately 35 students). We have a total of four counselors (two per site), as well as a total of six teachers (three per site) who help the children with their homework. It is our job and commitment to help better the lives of these children.
