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Salary Placement Schedules

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DEFINITIONS

Years of Experience for Pay Purposes: This applies to Instructional and Administrative employees. "Years of experience" shall be interpreted as the time an employee has been employed in a position or positions of equivalent classification, not the total years of service with Bay Haven Charter Academy, Inc. Progressive advancement in equivalent classifications shall allow an employee to retain their earned experience.

"Equivalent classification" means positions paid on the same Placement Schedule. An employee moving from a position on one Placement Schedule to a position on another Placement Schedule will begin the new position's pay grade at "0" years of experience, except in cases where the employee can document prior experience as an administrator or instructional employee. In such cases, the approved years of experience may be transferred to the appropriate Placement Schedule.

Administrative Experience: Only experience in an administrative position will count toward salary computation on the Administrative Placement Schedule (Placement Schedule 2), except for service in Professional Development or Administrative Assistant positions. Leadership roles held while employed as an instructional employee (e.g., department head, team leader) will not be considered. Acting as an administrator also does not count toward administrative experience.

Employees wishing to claim administrative experience must submit a written request to the Chief Financial Officer, including documentation of the specific assignments and time spent in qualifying administrative positions.

^{**}Stipends may be prorated based on term of service, responsibilities assigned, responsibilities fulfilled, principal's discretion, athletic director (if an athletic stipend). The Athletic Director and principals determine all athletic positions. Principals determine all other academic positions.

Instructional Substitutes

Daily Instructional Substitute Pay:

Instructional substitutes are required to have a minimum of a high school diploma. The rate of pay will be \$112.50 per day based on a 7.5-hour day.

Instructional substitutes with a Master's Degree will be paid \$120.00 per day based on a 7.5-hour day.

Long-Term Substitutes: Long-term substitutes will be paid at the Daily Instructional rate for the first 20 consecutive work days. On the 21st consecutive work day, the long-term substitute will move to the \$183.67 daily rate.

Individuals in this classification are working towards certification by the Florida Department of Education and are filling a vacant instructional position on a full-time basis.

Administrative/Supervisory Personnel

- For the Administrative Assistant position, instructional years of experience will be counted towards placement on the placement schedule. When an employee moves from an Administrative Assistant to another position on the administrative schedule, only administrative years will be counted towards placement on the placement schedule.
- Employees on Placement Schedule 2 may be awarded an advanced degree stipend. The advanced degree must be in the area they are currently working. The Charter School statute does not require administrators to have advanced degrees. Therefore, the following stipends are available after verification of policy parameters are met: Master's Degree: \$2,500; Specialist Degree: \$5,100; Doctorate: \$7,800. The exception is Instructional Specialists with a Master's degree. Instructional Specialists that do not possess a Master's Degree are paid on the A6 paygrade, while Instructional Specialists that have a Master's Degree are paid on the A7 paygrade. Therefore, Instructional Specialists with a Master's Degree are paid the difference between \$2,500 and the A7 paygrade amount when placed.
- All positions on Placement Schedule 2 are employed 250 days annually.

The employee will receive the difference between the Master's stipend amount and the A6 and A7 amount. Example: The difference between A6 and A7 for year 0 is \$1,970, so the employee is receiving an increased amount of \$1,970. The employee would receive a prorated Master stipend of \$530 (\$2,500-\$1,970)
