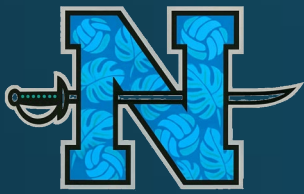

- 5th year NBH HS Girls and 3rd year Boys Head Volleyball Coach

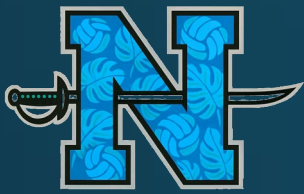

- **NEW** – Electrocardio Gram is required starting in 2026

Complete and upload [NFHSLearn.com](#) free training courses. Screenshot or download and save your completion certificate.

- Heat Illness, Sudden Cardiac Arrest, Concussion for Students, Sportsmanship
- Social Media for Student - This is a NBH Volleyball requirement and does not have to be uploaded.

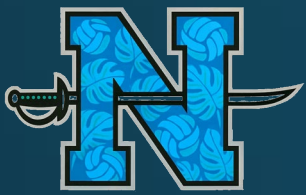

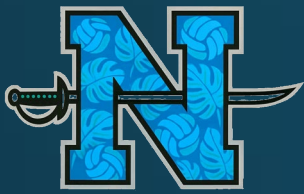

Financial Plan

Bottom line - Expensive to run the program and the following is not all inclusive.

- 2025 Costs:
 - MS - \$10,000+
 - Girls HS - \$74,000+
 - Boys HS - \$12,000+
- Transportation
 - Buses - average \$1800 per match
 - Vans - \$45 per day or monthly rentals
 - Gas - \$1500
 - Total: \$11,000+
- 2025 Referee costs
 - MS - \$70 (\$2,000)
 - JV - \$148
 - Girls Varsity - \$188 (\$10,000 for JV and Varsity matches)
 - Boys Varsity - \$188 (\$2300+)
- HUDL - \$1500
- Program Team Photos - \$1500
- Program End of year gathering - \$6,500+



Financial Plan

Estimated 2026 Player fees

- MS - Team A \$350 ... Team B \$250
- JV - \$550
- Girls Varsity - \$750
- Boys - \$300
- Plus, all players must obtain one \$300 banner; if not met, \$300 will be added to player fees.
Additional sales direct to player fees.

Volunteering and Fundraising opportunities

- Ironman– 9 May (Half 70.3) and 7 Nov (Full 140.6)
- Gulf Coast Jam – May 23-27 and June 1
- Concessions and Tournaments
- Banners (\$500/\$300/\$50)
- Elementary School Field Day
- Online Fundraising (Vertical Raise)
 - (HS Var) 250 – 25%, 500 – 50%, 750 – 75%, 1000 – 100%, 1500 – 100% and banner met
 - (HS JV) 150 – 25%, 300 – 50%, 550 – 75%, 1000 – 100% and banner met
 - (MS) 200 – 50%, 400 – 100%
 - (Boys) 200 – 50%, 400 – 100%, 750 – 100% and banner met

Parent/player support requirement

- 5 events required (concessions/volunteer events). 1 person attending 1 event = 1 event complete
- Full participation needed for North Bay Haven Tournaments from players and parents
